



**Using MINO When Traveling Abroad**

When using MINO abroad, the mobile carrier treats the call with MINO as an incoming call and charges incoming roaming fees. However, if while abroad, you have access to a local landline or a local mobile phone, you can avoid the incoming roaming fees.

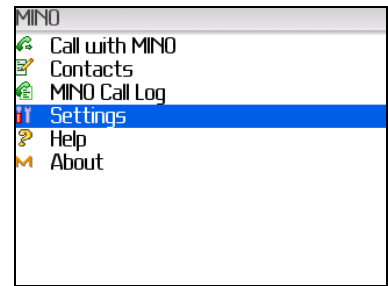

## Changing the MINO Default Call From Number

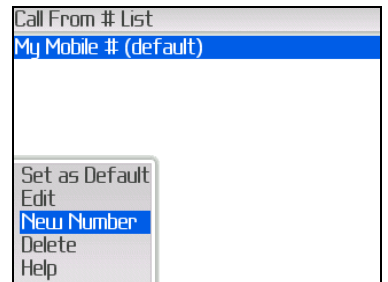
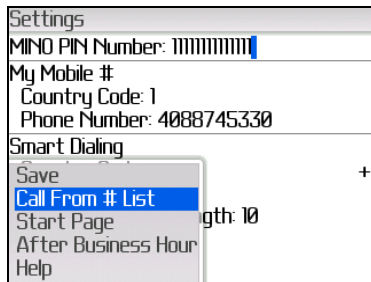
By default, the MINO Call From Number is set to your mobile number. When traveling abroad, you can change your default Call From Number to a local landline or mobile. As a result, your local landline or mobile will ring when you initiate a MINO call. This easy-to-do change enables you to call anywhere using MINO without incoming roaming fees.

### On a BlackBerry® Smartphone

- 1/ Launch the MINO application  
Click on [Settings](#)



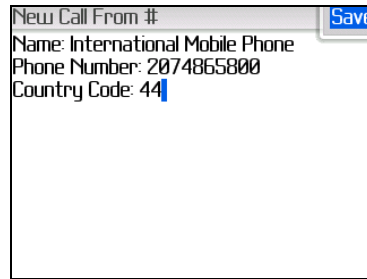
- 2/ Click on the Menu key  
Click on [Call From # List](#)  
Click on the Menu key  
Click on [New Number](#)



- 3/ Enter the Name, local Phone Number and Country Code

Click on the Menu key

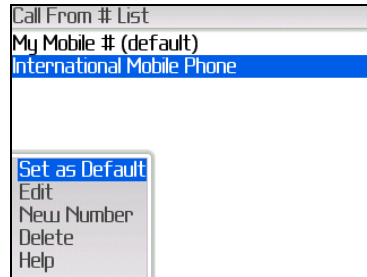
Click on Save



- 4/ Highlight your new number

Click on the Menu Key

Select Set as Default

### On a Windows Mobile Handheld Device

You have two options to change the MINO Default Call From Number:

#### **Option 1:** Through Settings in the MINO application

- 1/ Launch the MINO application

Click on Settings



- 2/ Enter the new default Country Code and Phone Number in My Mobile #

Click on Menu

Click on Save



**Option 2:** Through Call With MINO

1/ Launch the MINO application

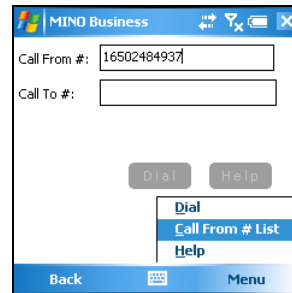
Click on Call With MINO



2/ Go in the Call From # field

Click on Menu

Choose Call From # List



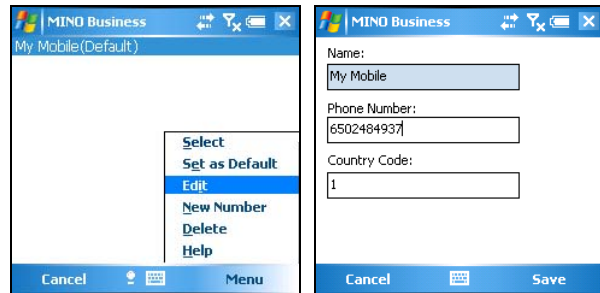
3/ Highlight the default number

Click on Menu

Click on Edit

Enter the new default Name,  
Country Code and Phone Number

Click Save

## Changing the MINO Call From Number for One Call

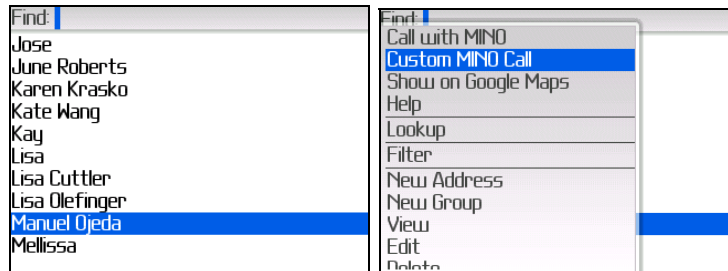
When traveling abroad, you might not want to use the same local landline or mobile number for each call you place using MINO. MINO allows you to change the Call From Number for just one call. After you have placed your call, the Call From Number will go back to your default.

### On a BlackBerry® Smartphone

- 1/ Select the contact you would like to call from your address book

Click on the Menu key

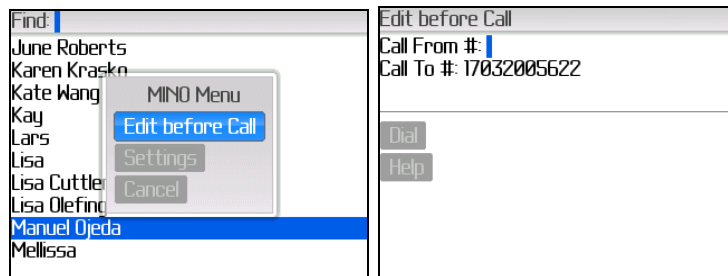
Choose Custom MINO Call



- 2/ Choose Edit before Call

Enter the new Call From Number

Click on Dial



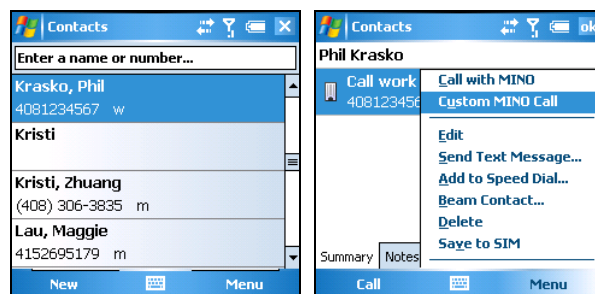

Click on Menu

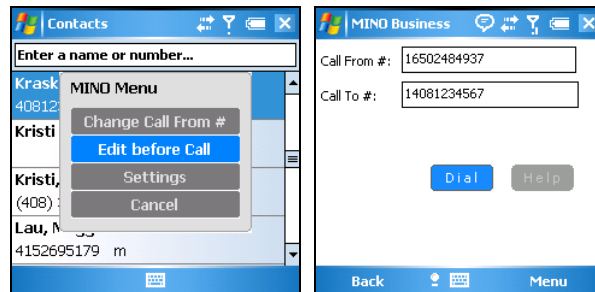
Choose Custom MINO Call

## Placing a Call Using MINO WebCall



To create a password, refer to **MINO WebCall: User Manual**


2/ Choose the country you are calling from (the country code is automatically entered)
